ABSTRACT SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

Authors are invited to submit **original and unpublished abstracts** related to any of the conference sub-themes. The Scientific Committee will evaluate all submissions based on originality, relevance, scientific merit, and clarity.

General Instructions

- Only **abstracts** are to be submitted. **Full paper submission is not required** for this conference.
- Abstracts must contain **original research, review, case study, or innovative applications** that have not been published or presented elsewhere.
- The abstract should be written in **English** using **British English** throughout.
- The maximum length of the abstract should be **300–500 words**, excluding the title, author information, and keywords.
- Include **3–5 keywords** immediately below the abstract.
- Use **Times New Roman, 12 pt font, single line spacing**, and **justified alignment** with **A4 page size** and **2.5 cm margins** on all sides.
- The title should be **bold, 14 pt, centre aligned**, followed by the names of the author(s), affiliation(s), and the corresponding author's e-mail address.
- All submissions should be prepared in **Microsoft Word (.doc/.docx)** format.
- The corresponding author should ensure that all co-authors have approved the submitted abstract.
- The Scientific Committee reserves the right to accept or reject any submission based on the review process.

Abstract Structure

The abstract should preferably include the following sections:

- **Background / Introduction**
- **Objectives**
- **Methodology**
- **Results / Findings**
- **Conclusion**
- **Keywords (3–5)**
- **References (1-2)**

Important Note

- All accepted abstracts must be presented by a **registered author** during the conference.
- The registration fee is **non-refundable**.
